About University

Kavikulaguru Kalidas Sanskrit University (KKSU) was established on 18 September 1997. It is named to pay rich tribute to Legendary Sanskrit Mahakavi Kalidasa. KKSU is an institution dedicated to the advanced learning of Sanskrit. It is located at Ramtek which falls under Nagpur District, the second capital of Maharashtra. It is the first Sanskrit University of Maharashtra.

History of Establishment: The former Prime Minister of India, P.V. Narasimha Rao, who is the great Scholar of Sanskrit, was keen on setting up an independent Sanskrit University in Maharashtra. With encouragement from Mr. Rao, the late CM of Maharashtra Shri S. Naik took up the issue and appointed Dr. S. Jichkar as one member committee to give a study report for establishing the Sanskrit University in Maharashtra. Dr. Jichkar prepared the study report and a non-formal University act for the establishment of Sanskrit University in Maharashtra. One of the Prominent Scholar of Sanskrit and Eminent personality of Vidarbha region Dr. Pankaj Chande was the Founder Vice-Chancellor of Kavikulguru Kalidas Sanskrit University.

The UGC recognized University with 12B & 2f status and accredited by NAAC with B++. It gives recognition to the educational institution for specialized studies in the jurisdiction of Maharashtra & Goa. It is a prominent research centre for researchers.

Sanskrit for All

- While having the entire Maharashtra state as its jurisdiction, the university is catering to the needs in the field of education in many modern disciplines like Yoga, Public Administration, Computer Applications, Library Science, Social work, Education, Hospitality Management, Fine Arts, and Performing Arts and so on through various academic programs in direct mode and distance mode also. It has made Sanskrit reachable to all irrespective of age, caste, creed or gender.
- All these modern programs have content from Ancient Indic Wisdom along with 20% content from Sanskrit directly.
- Apart from this, the university is offering more than 50 certificate and diploma programs in various subjects including Naturopathy, Panchakrma Chikitsa, Vastuvidya etc. with a blend of subjects to suit for contemporary skilling programs.

Sanskrit for Future

- The University is marching towards making the Sanskrit content available to modern fields of studies and disciplines. In this
 aspect, the university is engaging with other modern universities.
- A number of Memorandum of Understanding and Agreements is signed with many other academic institutions. KKSU and Maharashtra Law University together are offering a Certificate program in Shastric Methodology of Argumentation for legal practitioners with a view to provide the basis of Shastric approach.

Objectives




- (5) To prepare bands of Acharyas imbibed with wisdom and vision of Indic knowledge system.

- (8) To prepare and publish learning-teaching materials (including audio-visual materials) relevant to the studies;







Ramtek Campus - Facilities

Main Campus at Ramtek - An Island of Ancient Wisdom

Stretched in ten acres of land in Ramtek, the main campus has the Administrative Building, Academic Building, Guest house and Hostel. New Traditional Courses are introduced in this Campus from the year 2018-19.

Manuscript Resource Centre (MRC)

Kavikulaguru Kalidas Sanskrit University. Ramtek is a recognized Manuscript Resource Centre of National Mission for Manuscripts, New Delhi, since 2004. MRC seeks to develop a holistic approach in locating, documenting, protecting and making accessible the significant information of the manuscripts heritage of India. Some of the objectives of the center are manuscript survey, data collection, documentation, Mostly the manuscripts cover various subjects of Sanskrit, regional languages and literature. The MRC has so far documented 12164 data of manuscripts covering Vidarbha region of Maharashtra.

Jnanyayogi Shrikanta Jichkar Knowledge Resource Center (Library)

The University Library is named after Dr. Shrikant Jichkar as **Jnanyayogi Shrikanta Jichkar Knowledge Resource Center. It** has joined the UGC INFONET e-journal consortium for accessing full text and bibliographic database since Jan, 2014. Various e- resources are available to use online for KKSU students and teachers as well as other users.

Examination Section

The examination section handles the enrolment of students, examination and results and convocation. The examination section has a computerized examination system and around 250 examinations processed per year All the activities at examination section are computerized. The University has it's own "On-screen valuation centre" for valuation of answer books, Evaluation of all answer scripts of all examinations is conducted through Central Assessment Program (CAP). The results of every exam conducted are declared within 30 days or maximum of 45 days. Thus, the examination section adopts a model examination system characterized by confidentiality, impartiality, accuracy, speed by implementing confidential mechanism regarding appointment of paper setters, evaluation and revaluation, store and use of examination material and declaration of results.

National Service Scheme

The NSS wing of the University has four units and it has brought laurels to the University, The NSS students won many prizes as best volunteer in many activities at State level. The two NSS officers received awards as best program officer it has adopted two villages one in Nagpur district and one in Chandrapur district Activities like University level Special camp at Morava, Cleanliness drive, Blood donation camp, Health check up camp for villagers Compost tank for waste management are organised every year

Affiliated colleges

This University is an affiliatory University. Jurisdiction of the University is Maharashtra and Goa. There are 110 affiliated colleges of the University at present. The University has one conducted college namely "KKSU College of Education.

Centre for Training for Competitive Examinations

The university has started Centre for Competitive Examination at Ramtek campus Students are guided for MPSC, UPSC and various competitive examinations and also guided for NET. SET examination.

Skill Development Centre:

University has established Skill Development Centre for the students in Ramtek campus.

The University is providing Hostel and mess facility for Students.

Scholarship:

Monthly Scholarship will be given to regular research scholars. All UG & PG students are liable to get either Govt. scholarship or University Scholarship as per norms.

The P G Department of University has an Alumni Association to bring all alumni together to organize various activities like seminars contributing to the development of the Alma mate.
